**Preamble** : The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1.

The notation '[DP]' in a rule means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

**Prevention of violence and incivility** : The FFVoile recalls that sporting events are above all a space for exchange and sharing open and accessible to all.

As such, competitors and support persons are asked to behave in all circumstances, ashore and on the water, in a courteous and respectful manner regardless of the origin, gender or sexual orientation of other participants.

## 1 RULES

The Regatta is governed by:

- 1.1 - the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing,
- 1.2 - National prescriptions, translated for non-French speaking competitors, in joined appendix named "prescriptions",
- 1.3 - Federal regulations, in particular the technical regulations for competitive sporting practices and charters of the FFVoile,
- 1.4 ISCYRA Star Class Rules.
- 1.5 When this notice of race is translated, the French text will take precedence.

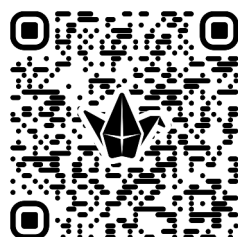
## 2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SIs)

- 2.1 The SIs will be available after 9:00 a.m. on Friday October 31 at CVP registration.
- 2.2 The SIs will be posted according to FFVoile prescription on official notice board located on club-house terrace.
- 2.3 The SIs will be available in digital version on online information board indicated in 3.1

**3.2** [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

**3.3** For safety reasons, **boats shall carry a VHF radio** onboard and monitor the race channel, where signals regarding **barge traffic** and information for competitors, such as OCS notifications, can be broadcast.

**3.4** On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The race channel will be stated in the SIs.

#### **4 ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION**

In accordance with RRS76.1, the organizers will reject or cancel the entry of any competitor of Russian or Belarusian nationality or displaying these nationalities and the participation of any boats whose owner or manager is a Russian or Belarusian individual or entity.

**4.1** The event is open to all boats of the **STAR** class.

**4.2** Required documents for registration:

**4.2.1** a) For each competitor having a FFVoile Club licence:

- the valid FFVoile club licence with “Competition” mention
- or
- the valid FFVoile club licence with “Adhesion” or “Pratique” mention, accompanied with
  - for minors, a testimonial of completion of a questionnaire related to the health condition of the minor competitor
  - for adults, a medical certificate dated less than one year, mentioning the absence of any medical objection to participate in sailing competition

b) For each competitor without a FFVoile Club licence, whether foreign or French national living abroad shall present during registration:

- a supporting document to justify membership to a World Sailing Member national authority.
- a supporting document to justify a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 2 million Euros.
- for minors, a testimonial of completion of a questionnaire related to the health condition of the minor competitor or, for adults, a medical certificate dated less than one year, mentioning the absence of any medical objection to participate in sailing competition

c) a parental authorization for any minor competitor.

**4.2.2** For the boat:

- the measurement form or rating certificate of the boat, when its presentation is required by a rule
- if necessary a valid authorization to display advertising on the boat.

**4.4** Eligible boats can register online, no later than Monday October 27, on :

**4.5** To be considered as registered in the event, a boat shall be in good standing with all entry requirements and pay any fees.

#### **5 FEES**

**5.1** Entry fees are as follows: €180 per boat, including registration fees, Saturday night dinner for the crew (helmsman and crew) and Open bar for the 3 days of the regatta.

**5.2** Other fee : Friday evening crew diner 20 € per guest.

**6** **ADVERTISING** not applicable.

#### **8 PROGRAM**

**8.1** **Registration confirmation** : Thursday October 30 from 4 p.m.

Saturday November 1<sup>st</sup> from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. and Sunday 2 from 9 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.

**8.4 Number of races :** Races to follow depending on weather conditions..

**8.5 The warning signal of first race each day is scheduled at :**

## **12 THE COURSES**

The route to be taken will be of the type built between buoys located upstream and downstream of CVP.

## **13 PENALTY SYSTEM**

RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty..

## **14 RANKING**

**14.2** 2 races are required to be completed to complete the regatta.

**14.3** The score of a boat in a series shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst scores:

a) When fewer than **4** races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

b) When from **4 to 7** races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

c) When **8** races or more have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

## **18 DATA PROTECTION**

### **18.1 Image and appearance rights**

Participating in the competition, the competitor and his legal representative authorize the OA, the FFVoile and their sponsors to use free of charge his image and his name, to show at any time (during and after the competition) static or moving pictures, films or TV recording, as well as other reproduction from himself done during the competition, and this on any support and for any use related to the promotion of their activities.

### **18.2 Use of personal data of participants**

Participating in this competition, the competitor and his legal representatives agree to and authorize the FFVoile, its sponsors, as well as the OA to use and store, free of charge, his personal data. These data may be published by FFVoile and its sponsors. The FFVoile mainly, but also its sponsors may use these data for the development of softwares or with marketing purposes. In accordance with the « Règlement Général sur la Protection des Données (RGPD) » (General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)), any competitor having transmitted his personal data to the FFVoile, may exercise his right to access to his own data, have them modified, and, depending on the situations, have them deleted, limited, or to object them, sending an email to [dpo@ffvoile.fr](mailto:dpo@ffvoile.fr) or a letter to the Head Office of the Fédération Française de Voile, mentioning that the request is related to personal data.

## **19 RECOGNITION OF RISKS**

RRS 3 mentions: « The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue *racing* is hers alone. » Participating in this event, each competitor agrees and acknowledge the fact that sailing is potentially a dangerous activity with specific risks. These risks include strong winds and rough sea, sudden changes of weather conditions, failure of equipment, mistakes in boat handling, bad navigation of other boats, loss of balance on unstable surface, and causing increased risk of injury. The risk of material and/or physical damage is therefore inherent in the sport of sailing.

## **Prescriptions of the Fédération Française de Voile (FFVoile) Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028**

Version of 15th of October 2024

FFVoile Prescription to RRS 25.1 (Notice of race, sailing instructions and signals)

For events graded 4 and 5, standard notices of race and sailing instructions including the specificities of the event shall be used. Events graded 4 may have dispensation for such requirement, after receipt of FFVoile approval, received before the notice of race has been published. For events graded 5, posting of sailing instructions will be considered as meeting the requirements of RRS 25.1 application. These standard documents can be downloaded on the "Arbitrage" website of FFVoile. <https://arbitrage.ffvoile.fr>

(\* FFVoile Prescription to RRS 60.5(d) (Decisions on protests concerning class rules)

The protest committee may ask the parties to the protest, prior to checking procedures, a deposit covering the cost of checking arising from a protest concerning class rules.

(\* FFVoile Prescription to RRS 65.1 (Legal liability)

Any question or request related to legal liability arising from an incident occurred while a boat was bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing depends on the appropriate courts and cannot be examined and dealt by a protest committee. A boat that retires from a race or accepts a penalty does not, by that such action, admit legal liability.

(\* FFVoile Prescription to RRS 70.3(b) (Appeals and requests to a national authority)

The denial of the right of appeal is subject to the written approval of the FFVoile, received at least 2 months before the event. This approval shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.

(\* FFVoile Prescription to RRS 76.1 (Exclusion of boats or competitors)

An organizing authority or race committee shall not reject or cancel the entry of a boat or exclude a competitor eligible under the notice of race and sailing instructions for an arbitrary reason.

(\* FFVoile Prescription to RRS 78.1 (Compliance with class rules; certificates)

The boat's owner or other person in charge shall, under his sole responsibility, make sure moreover that his boat complies with the equipment and security rules required by the laws, by-laws and regulations of the Administration.

(\* FFVoile Prescription to RRS 86.3 (Changes to the racing rules)

An organizing authority wishing to change a rule listed in RRS 86.1(a) in order to develop or test new rules shall first submit the changes to the FFVoile, in order to obtain its written approval and shall report the results to FFVoile after the event. Such approval shall be mentioned in the notice of race and in the sailing instructions and shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.

(\* FFVoile Prescription to RRS 88.2 (Changes or deletions to National prescriptions)

Prescriptions of the FFVoile shall not be changed or deleted in the notice of race and sailing instructions, except for events for which an international jury has been appointed. In such case, the prescriptions marked with an asterisk (\*) shall not be changed in the notice of race and sailing instructions. (The official translation of the prescriptions, downloadable on "Arbitrage" website of FFVoile shall be the only translation used to comply with RRS 90.2(b)).

(\* FFVoile Prescription to RRS 91(a) (Minimum number of protest committee members)

The protest committee shall be composed of a minimum number of committee members in accordance with the provisions of the federal regulations of the FFVoile, unless a derogation is granted by the FFVoile

(\* FFVoile Prescription to RRS 91(b) (Appointment of an international jury)

The appointment of an international jury meeting the requirements of Appendix N is subject to prior written approval of the FFVoile. Such approval shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.
